MEMORANDUM

Sub: Award of Tamil Nadu Government's Special Scholarship to the Children of Employees of Police Department upto the Rank of Inspector of Police/Office Superintendents for the Academic year 2011-2012 - Applications called for - Regarding.

Ref: G.O. Ms. No.837, Home (Pol. IX) Department Dated 18.07.2008.

The Government in their G.O. Ms. 837, Home (Pol. IX) Department Dated 18.07.2008 have restructured the Tamil Nadu Government Special Scholarship by including the Ministerial Staff also into the Scheme and also increased the Number of Special Scholarship from 9 to 100 to those who score higher marks in 12th Standard Government Examinations held in March/April 2011 and also increased the Special Scholarship Amount to Rs.20,000/- or the amount paid to the institutions which ever is less for 4 years or till the course is completed to the 100 Children of Employees of Police Department.

2. This Special Scholarship is awarded to the first 100 children who secure higher marks in 12th Standard Government Examinations held in March/April 2010.

3. It is observed from the previous years, that more than 300 children are getting 1100 and above marks and every year the number of students who score higher marks is increasing. Hence, The Unit Officers are requested to forward only the applications of those students who have scored more than 1100 marks in 12th Standard Government Examinations held in March/April 2011 including the Prize winners of 2011 and who joined higher Studies, to Chief Office.

4. A specimen of Application in Form-I and copy of instructions for grant of Tamil Nadu Government's Special Scholarship to the children of Employees of Police Department up to the Rank of Inspector of Police/Office Superintendents are enclosed. The applications should be obtained in the prescribed form-I with Xerox Copy of Mark Sheet and Fees Receipt duly Attested and Bonafide Student Certificate must be enclosed with the application. It must be ensured that only fee

receipt copies are enclosed and not fee structures etc., The Unit Officers are requested to scrutinize all the applications and compile as per the enclosed instructions.

5. All the Unit Officers are requested to obtain applications with Bonafide Student Certificate and all Fees receipts paid by the student studying in college as per the prescribed form and forward only the applications of those students who have Scored ~~100~~ and above Marks in the 12th Standard Government Examinations held in March/April 2011 to reach Chief Office on or before **30.11.2011.**



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Children of Employees of Police Department in service up to the rank of Inspector of Police/ Office Superintendent are alone eligible for the award of the Special scholarship.
- 2) Only two children of an Employee of Police Department are eligible for the grant of Special Scholarship. The Unit Officer should adhere to this strictly
- 3) The candidates entering courses like Medicine, Engineering, Law, Management Courses/Information Technology related subjects and all Degree Courses are eligible.
- 4) Application for the Special Scholarship should be submitted in duplicate to the Head of the Office under whom the Executive/Ministerial Staff is serving or last served (i.e.COP/SP/CMT etc.,).
- 5) Xerox Copy of Mark Sheet and All Fees Receipts duly attested and Bonafide Student Certificate must be enclosed with the application. Incomplete Applications should not be entertained at any cost.
- 6) The marks obtained by the students in the +2 Standard Examination conducted by the State Board of School Examinations, Tamil Nadu for 2011 shall be considered and merit will be the sole criterion.
- 7) The Ranking is based only on the percentage of marks obtained by the Student in the 12th Standard Government Examinations held in March 2011.
- 8) All the Unit Officers are requested to forward the applications who score 1100 and above Marks only in the 12th Standard Government Examinations held in March 2010 and also requested that not to send the improvement cases.
- 9) Special Scholarship paid at the rate of Rs.20,000/- or the Tuition Fees Paid by the student which ever is less is paid for 4 years or till the course is completed.
- 10) Every year the amount is released only after the submission of "Bonafide Student Certificates and Tuition Fees Receipt" from the educational institutions.
- 11) All the applications should be arranged in Descending Order in respect of their Marks and neatly tied in tact.
- 12) Applications in respect of the children of the Executive/Ministerial Staff working in Special Units such as Railway Police, TSP Battalions, CID units, Vigilance and Anti-corruption units, etc. should be forward the applications to Chief Office.
