## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR 11<sup>th</sup> ALL INDIA RIFLE, PISTOL AND CARBINE SHOOTING DUTY MEET 2010

**Introduction:** The 11<sup>th</sup> All India Pistol and Carbine Shooting Duty Meet 2010 will be held at Chennai from June 2011. Tamil Nadu Police will be the host.

1. **Location of the Range:** The firing ranges are located in Kancheepuram District and it is about 40 Kms south of Chennai. Any one interested in seeing the range may do so through Google Earth with the above Co-ordinates:  
12°47' 40.30'' N 80° 06' 30.00'' E
2. **Accessibility:** Chennai is easily accessible by road, train and air.
3. **Climate:** The weather in Chennai during January is normally pleasant during day and mild cold during night. Light cotton bedding is sufficient. No need for woolen clothing or bedding.
4. **Participation:** All State Police and CPOs Teams would be participating in the 11<sup>th</sup> All India Rifle, Pistol and Carbine Shooting Duty Meet 2010. The schedule of events will be sent later. The teams will report on 17.01.2011.
5. **Eligibility criteria:** Every competitor participating in the competition must have completed a minimum of one year of continuous service in Police Department as on 31.12.2010 and a certificate to that effect at the bottom of the entry form should be appended duly signed by an officer not below the rank of Inspector General of Police. The Entry Forms should contain names of only shooters participating and maximum of only one substitute per event as laid down by the All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi.

6. **Entry Form & Nominal Roll:** (a) Specimen of Entry Form of each competition is enclosed at **Annexure "A"**. Two copies of the Entry Form along with nominal roll duly filled in may please be sent to the Organising Secretary, 11<sup>th</sup> All India Rifle, Pistol and Carbine Shooting Duty Meet, 'Marudham Complex', No.17 Boat Club Road, Raja Annamalai Puram, Chennai 600 028. on or before 15.12.2010. A copy of the same may also be sent to the Secretary, Central Co-ordinating Committee, IB, "E" Block No.8, Level-7, R.K. Puram, New Delhi.

(b) The participating teams are also requested to take note of revised rules governing the rates and payments of entry fee for the Duty Meet. As per the latest instructions, the entry fee has to be deposited at the rate of Rs.50/- per participant including reserves, Managers and Coaches. This fee in lump sum in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft favouring **Organizing Secretary "AIPDM 2010 (Shooting Competition, Chennai)"** payable at Chennai along with the entry forms and the nominal rolls duly certified should be sent to the **Organising Secretary, 11<sup>th</sup> All India Rifle, Pistol and Carbine Shooting Duty Meet 2010, "Marudham Complex", No.17 Boat Club Road, R.A. Puram, Chennai 600 028.**

7. **Conduct:** The Shooting Competition will be conducted as per the AIPDM Rules Book as amended in 2010. The conduct of the Shooting Events are enclosed in **Annexure-B.**

8. **Referees/Judges:** Well qualified and experienced shooters from the host State and those nominated by the Central Co-ordination Committee will be engaged for conduct of the competition.

10. **Opening / Closing Ceremony:**

- a) All shooters should participate in the Opening / Closing Ceremony.
- b) **Dress:** Working Uniform will be worn by all ranks.
- c) The rehearsal for the Opening Ceremony shall be held on the 17 & 18<sup>th</sup> January 2011 at Tamil Nadu Police Academy, Oonamancherry, Chennai. Detailed programme in this connection will be sent in due course.

- d) Each team will bring two flags of their own State colour of the sizes of 6' x 4' & 3' x 2'.
11. **Trophies:** All the trophies won at the last Duty Meet may be arranged to be delivered to the Secretary, Central Co-ordinating Committee, New Delhi by 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010.
12. **Accommodation:** Accommodation will be given for the team members near the Shooting Range. Separate accommodations will be provided for the Team Managers and Coaches as well as participants of the rank of Gazetted Officers. Separate accommodation will be provided to the women participants. All personnel including officials should bring their bedding including mosquito net. **It will not be possible to provide family accommodation to any officer accompanying the team.**
13. **Mess:** All AIPDM teams are expected to bring their Mess, Utensils, etc. Dry and fresh ration like Vegetables, Milk, Egg, Mutton, Chicken and fish will be made available by the Organising Committee on payment. Demand for the same, giving dining strength, etc should be submitted to the Organising Secretary by the 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010 so as to enable us to procure the same. Separate kitchen facilities will be provided to all the teams.
14. **Cooking Gas:** The Organising Committee will arrange to supply gas cylinder as well as gas stoves to all the teams on payment. All the teams should bring their own cooking utensils accordingly. No firewood will be allowed to be used for cooking.
15. **Medical:** One Medical Aid Post shall also be established at the Firing Range.
16. **Control Room:** A round-the-clock "Control Room" will be established at the Tamil Nadu Police Academy/Triveni Academy with effect from 12.01.2011 till the departure of all the teams. Arrival and departure of the teams would be

registered at the Control Room for further management. The following information will be available at the Control Room:

- i) Programme of matches.
- ii) Latest Results and Teams Ranking
- iii) Arrival & Departure of teams
- iv) Air / Bus / Train Timings
- v) Cultural activities
- vi) Places of interest in and around Chennai
- vii) Any other information.

17. **Security Arrangements:** In order to ensure security, all officials and members of the teams will be required to carry their Identity cards. Every member of the participating teams should bring with them **two recent photographs of passport size** in uniform duly attested for the purpose of preparing Duty Meet Card.
18. **Transport:** As most of the Teams and Team Managers are expected to come by train. Vehicles will be provided to receive the teams at Chennai Railway Station to bring them to the place of stay. Similar arrangements will be made at Chennai Airport for the Teams and Team Managers coming by air. Vehicles will be provided to the Team Managers to commute from their place of stay to the Firing Range every day. It is emphasized that it will not be possible to provide individual vehicles to the Officers.
19. **Arrival of Teams:** All participating teams are expected to reach Chennai Railway Station by 16<sup>th</sup> January 2011. It is emphasized that it will not be possible to render any Admn. Assistance to the teams arriving at Chennai before 16<sup>th</sup> January 2011. Accordingly, all the teams may intimate the exact date well in advance for providing Transportation. A reception center would be established at the Railway Station, Chennai. Teams are requested to send nominal rolls of their participants and detail of Administration Party clearly stating their strength, rank-wise in duplicate by 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010. Since Railway have their well established computer network throughout the country,

return journey reservation may please be made by the teams themselves, since it will not be possible to arrange for rail reservation at short notice.

20. **Discipline:** A very high standard of discipline is expected from all Officers and men of the participating teams. The Team Managers will be personally responsible for orderly conduct of their team members during the period of the Meet.
21. **Arms & Ammunition and other equipment:** All teams are requested to make their own arrangements for their safekeeping. However, they can also avail themselves of Bell of Arms facilities at Tamil Nadu Police Academy.
22. **Uniform:** All the members of the participating teams are requested to wear their prescribed working uniforms during various competitions and also during the Opening and Closing Ceremonies. They should also compulsorily display Meet Identity Card issued by the Secretary of 11<sup>th</sup> All India Rifle, Pistol and Carbine Shooting Duty Meet 2010.

- (v) On command load firer will attain BC position (weapon must be at the belt level) and load the carbine with change lever on 'A' and cocked.
- (vii) **Ready** on the **right**, **Ready** on the **left**, ready on the firing line (gap of 1sec) **FIRE** (firer will engage the target in BC position with a burst of 2 rds only on each target)
- (viii) Ceasefire **UNLOAD**
- (ix) Pick up empties
- (x) Check target, advance

#### 3.5.2 Firing line commands for MATCH IV, PRACTICE-II.

- (i) Relay no..... on the firing line
- (ii) Check target
- (iii) **Show Ammn** (after verifying correct quantity of Amn, the RO gives command)

- (v) loading position (weapon to be at the belt level) on command load firer will load the carbine with change lever on '**A**' or '**R**' and **cocked**.
- (vi) **Ready** on the **right**, **Ready** on the **left**, ready on the firing line (gap of 1sec) **FIRE**  
(firer will bring the weapon to the shoulder only after getting the command fire and engage the target and fire 2rds on each target. Not more than 2 shots on each target will be counted if there are more than 2 hits on a single target, only the best two shots will be counted.

- (viii) Pick up empties
- (ix) Check target, advance.

- (i) Relay no. ... on firing line.
- (ii) Check target
- (iii) **Show Ammn** (after verifying correct quantity of ammn, the RO gives command)
- (iv) 8 rds magazine **Load**
- (v) Loading position (weapon to be at the belt level), on command load firer will load the carbine with change lever on '**A**' or '**R**' and **cocked**
- (vi) **Ready** on the **right**, **Ready** on the **left**, ready on the firing line (gap of 1 sec) **FIRE**. (firer will attain kneeling position and bring the weapon to the shoulder .fire to engage the target and fire 2 rds on each target. Not more than 2 shots on each target will be counted, if there are more than 2 hits on a single target, only the best two shots will be counted.
- (vii) Cease fire, **UNLOAD**, sling arm weapon
- (viii) Pick up empties
- (ix) Check target, advance

3.5.4. **PENALTIES:** For all the practices of match IV (Carbine) not more than 2 shots on each target will be counted. If there are more than 2 hits on a single target, only the best two shots will be counted. A penalty of one point will be imposed for each single shot fired and penalty of 5 pts will also be imposed for each un-hit-targets in Practice No.1.

In case of Match-I Practice-4 (Rifle Snap) and Match III Practice-4, Pistol Revolver Snap (a) if the Shooter fires on the dry exposure 2 pts will be deducted from the practice score (b) if a shooter fires two shots on a single exposure, highest hit will be deducted for as many times as two shots are fired

on one exposure. This penalty will be in addition to the deduction made due to firing on dry exposure if the firer does so.
